RAND-Safe Pricing Framework

(Internal + safe to summarize externally)

This is how you price with RAND compliance.

Licensing Categories (Non-Discriminatory by Class)

A. Financial Institutions (Banks, Credit Unions)

- Scope: Internal production use
- Metric: Institution size or transaction tier
- Structure:
- Annual license
- Optional per-TPS scaling
- Typical range (illustrative, not public):
- Regional banks: low six figures annually
- Tier-1 banks: scaled enterprise rate

B. Payment Networks / Processors

- Scope: Multi-bank or network use
- Metric: Throughput or endpoints
- Structure:
- Platform license
- Annual support + certification

C. Vendors / Fintech / Wallet Providers

- Scope: Embedded or redistributable implementation
- Metric: Deployment volume
- Structure:
- OEM or SDK license
- Royalty or certification-based

D. Regulators / National QR Systems

- Scope: Nationwide deployment
- Metric: Jurisdictional scope
- Structure:
- Negotiated sovereign license
- Long-term term (10–20 years typical)

RAND compliance guardrails

- Same class → same pricing logic
- No exclusion of competitors
- Transparent terms
- Geography-neutral

Bank-Facing FAQ

Q: Is X9.150 royalty-free?

A: No. ASC X9 standards do not grant patent rights. Some implementations may require licensing from the patent holder. Nimbus-T Global inc is the patent holder.

Q: Does X9 license this technology?

A: No. X9 publishes standards but does not sublicense patented technology.

Q: Is Nimbus-T obligated to offer free licenses?

A: No. Nimbus-T has committed to RAND terms, which may include reasonable fees.

Q: If we implement X9.150 without licensing, are we covered?

A: Institutions are responsible for their own patent diligence.

Q: Why license now?

A: Licensing ensures legal certainty, audit defensibility, and long-term compliance as QR payments scale.
